## I. GREAT COMMITMENT

This is the prerequisite to the other two.

What does a great commitment look like?

### Proverbs 3:5-12 (New King James Version)

<sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart,  
And lean not on your own understanding;  
<sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him,  
And He shall direct<sup>[a]</sup> your paths.  
<sup>7</sup> Do not be wise in your own eyes;  
Fear the LORD and depart from evil.  
<sup>8</sup> It will be health to your flesh,<sup>[b]</sup>  
And strength<sup>[c]</sup> to your bones.  
<sup>9</sup> Honor the LORD with your possessions,  
And with the firstfruits of all your increase;  
<sup>10</sup> So your barns will be filled with plenty,  
And your vats will overflow with new wine.  
<sup>11</sup> My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD,  
Nor detest His correction;  
<sup>12</sup> For whom the LORD loves He corrects,  
Just as a father the son *in whom* he delights.

### Hebrews 11:6 (New King James Version)

<sup>6</sup> But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

## **John 2:23-25 (New King James Version)**

### **The Discerner of Hearts**

<sup>23</sup> Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name when they saw the signs which He did. <sup>24</sup> But Jesus did not commit Himself to them, because He knew all *men*, <sup>25</sup> and had no need that anyone should testify of man, for He knew what was in man.

Have you committed yourself to the point that Jesus is committed to you?

## **Matthew 7:21-23 (New King James Version)**

### **I Never Knew You**

<sup>21</sup> "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'

## **Acts 22:12-16 (New King James Version)**

<sup>12</sup> "Then a certain Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good testimony with all the Jews who dwelt *there*, <sup>13</sup> came to me; and he stood and said to me, 'Brother Saul, receive your sight.' And at that same hour I looked up at him. <sup>14</sup> Then he said, 'The God of our fathers has chosen you that you should know His will, and see the Just One, and hear the voice of His mouth. <sup>15</sup> For you will be His witness to all men of what you have seen and heard. <sup>16</sup> And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.'

## **Ephesians 5:17-18 (New King James Version)**

<sup>17</sup> Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord *is*. <sup>18</sup> And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

## **1 Thessalonians 4:3-8 (New King James Version)**

<sup>3</sup> For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexual immorality; <sup>4</sup> that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, <sup>5</sup> not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God; <sup>6</sup> that no one should take advantage of and defraud his brother in this matter, because the Lord *is* the avenger of all such, as we also forewarned you and testified. <sup>7</sup> For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness. <sup>8</sup> Therefore he who rejects *this* does not reject man, but God, who has also given<sup>[a]</sup> us His Holy Spirit.

## **Romans 12:1-2 (New King James Version)**

### **Romans 12**

#### **Living Sacrifices to God**

<sup>1</sup> I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

## **1 Corinthians 6:20 (New King James Version)**

<sup>20</sup> For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body<sup>[a]</sup> and in your spirit, which are God's.

## **2 Timothy 1:12 (New King James Version)**

<sup>12</sup> For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

Commitment- a pledge, or a promise; agreement

## **Matthew 28:18-20 (New King James Version)**

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore<sup>[a]</sup> and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." Amen.<sup>[b]</sup>

## **Luke 24:46-47 (New King James Version)**

<sup>46</sup> Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise<sup>[a]</sup> from the dead the third day, <sup>47</sup> and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

## **Romans 1:16-17 (New King James Version)**

### **The Just Live by Faith**

<sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ,<sup>[a]</sup> for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "*The just shall live by faith.*"
