John 1:14

¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

I Peter 1:23

²³ having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,^[a]

Revelation 19:13

¹³ He *was* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.

Galatians 4:4

⁴ But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born^[a] of a woman, born under the law,

Isaiah 40:5

⁵ The glory of the LORD shall be revealed,
And all flesh shall see *it* together;

³³ Nor is there any mediator between us,
Who may lay his hand on us both.

I. He Has Always Existed

John 1:1-2

Psalms 145:13

¹³ Your kingdom *is* an everlasting kingdom,
And Your dominion *endures* throughout all generations.^[a]

He is the Creator of all things v.3

Psalms 24:1

¹ The earth *is* the LORD's, and all its fullness,
The world and those who dwell therein.

II. He is Our Life v.14

John 3: 14-16

¹⁴ And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, ¹⁵ that whoever believes in Him should not perish but^[a] have eternal life. ¹⁶ For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

III. He Is Our Light v.5,9

Comprehend – cannot put out the light.

IV. He Was Rejected By His Own.

His own Domain – Nature
His own people – the Jews

BUT v.12

Right – authority

Believe – **Romans 10:9-10**

⁹ that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 1:16

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ,^[a] for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

V. Miracle Births v.13

Not of Blood
Nor the will of the Flesh
Nor the will of Man
But of God

v.14 Truth

Romans 1:18

¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

Truth is liberating

John 8:31-32

³¹ Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. ³² And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

It is the recognition of Truth by personal experience.
